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Vaping

- "Thinking about vaping / e-cigarettes only, which of the following best describes you?"
 - I have never vaped
 - I have vaped once or twice
 - I vape occasionally (less than once a week)
 - I vape regularly (once a week or more)



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- 6.4% of the 11,151 responses in 2022 vaped occasionally or regularly
- 3% of the 11,151 responses in 2022 vaped regularly (once a week or more)



Occasional/regular vaping by school year




Occasional/regular vaping by gender


Occasional/regular vaping by IMD Quintile (Q5 being LEAST deprived and Q1 being MOST deprived)


Odds of vaping compared to respondents in Quintile 5 (least deprived)




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
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


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
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What's next?

- Continue working with service providers and gather feedback

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
