- measles outbreaks happen when not enough children have been vaccinated
- measles can be a very serious disease, leading to ear and chest infections, fits, diarrhoea, and damage to the brain. if you can't remember if your Measles can kill
- vour child is at risk of measles if he or she hasn't had the MMR vaccination
- 2 doses of MMR vaccine are needed to get the best protection
- (the Red Book). If this doesn't help, speak to your GP if you don't know how many doses your child has had, it's better to have 2 doses of MMR vaccine now rather than risk


Measles outbreak leaflet – low literacy and in community languages






