ADPH London has now set up it's very own KHub's Network.

This Network collectively hosts all 11 of our thematic networks as "Groups" in one virtual space. This makes it easier to access meeting notes, presentations, and shared resources, as well as connect with other colleagues on the platform.

Rest assured email will still be the main form of communication for key updates, but <u>from now</u>, all meeting content will be hosted exclusively on KHub.

Signing Up

- To access ADPHL's KHub Network, sign-up via this link, using your organisational email.
- Once joined, type "ADPH London Thematic Networks" into the search bar and request to join our Network page.

Joining your Thematic Network Groups

Once you have joined the Network, request to join any of the thematic network Groups you belong to, or have an interest in. From the Network page, click on the **"Groups"** tab and "Request to join" the Groups listed.

Content Sharing

Once approved, you can engage with- and download content from network meetings. Materials such as meeting slide decks and notes will be uploaded to the site by your network co-ordinators after each meeting. Meeting content will no longer be shared via email or the ADPH London website, so it's important you are set up on KHub.
