1. SLI Action Plan Refresh

Discussions held between DsPH at the SW ADPH virtual away day led to a request to review the current SW SLI action plan. The current action plan is displayed below. The main aim from the away day discussions was to streamline this action plan and ensure that there is appropriate focus and added value for the priorities that will be maintained in the refreshed plan.



Streamlining the current action plan to contain fewer key objectives can aid us in further implementing the ADPH SLI impact report recommendations.

ADPH commissioned Shared Intelligence to review the delivery and impact of SLI. The Impact Report aimed to capture a picture of the delivery of SLI in the public health sector, the level of participation in SLI and its impact between 2019-20 and 2021-22. The report provides a brief outline of progress as well as a steer for the future of the programme to increase impact.

The following list summarises the impact report recommendations:

- Create a model of public health improvement that builds on the deeply embedded concept of Quality Improvement
- Establish a simple framework for monitoring impact across the spectrum of improvement activity
- Strengthen national & reginal co-ordination
- Establish a balanced portfolio of improvement activities
- Consider greater cross sector working

The following key objectives were agreed to be removed from the SLI action plan due to not fitting the local SLI scrutiny process phases (displayed below). The work behind these key objectives may still be ongoing, but it was considered they are no longer needed to be formally represented on the plan as they are 'business as usual' approaches.



We aim to gain a collaborative SW DsPH view on which key objectives should be brought forward into the refreshed SLI action plan for the next two years. To start this process, we have asked SW DsPH to indicate four key objectives from the plan that they believe hold the best potential for a collaborative SW SLI focus. The topics will fulfil the ADPH SLI impact report recommendations and possess the capacity to progress through each of the local scrutiny phases below, to maximise monitoring of impact:

Phase 1

Scoping, Development & Sharing of Good Practise:

- DPH lead identified and key outputs created
- Stocktake/Benchmarking Exercises & Surveys
- Workshop/conference planning
- Self assessments
- Bid processes for funding
- Establishing working groups/Cols
- Guidance development
- Sharing practice between LA's

Phase 2

Local Implementation

- Actioning tangible outcomes from survey results
- Workshops/conferences taking place to inform wider workforces
- Facilitating outcomes & improvements from self assessments
- Bids assigned and projects taking place from funding
- Guidance shared amongst South West

Phase 3

Measurable Outcomes and Review

- Quality Improvement achieved for a service
- Improved awareness/understanding of a PH topic for staff/residents
- Lessons learnt & best practise shared from projects (bid winners etc) and implemented into other LA's
