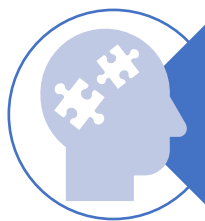
Best Start in Life

- Anna Freud Centre for Family Hubs project brief underway which aims to support leaders from Public Health, Children’s Social Care and NHS CYP commissioners in South West England to develop an integrated Start for Life offer through an iterative discovery, reflection and learning approach.

CVD Risk Reduction

- Facilitation of information sharing across South West local authorities is ongoing with the aim to improve knowledge on what is happening in the CVD space regionally. Exploration of how to improve the SWA DPH networks link to regional work is also in planning.



Behaviour Change & Climate Change

- Three behavioural science continual professional development webinars took place, introducing the subject, its concepts and models and its application to practise.
- A South West behavioural science community of practise has been initiated which aims to build on the momentum from the webinars and set focus for future direction



Public Mental Health

- A Southwest Real-time Suspected Suicide Surveillance (RTSSS) system self-assessment survey has been circulated and will help to inform and consolidate development of good practise within RTSSSS in the south west region. It will also help to identify gaps and inform action at a local system level and address key challenges to be addressed.



Healthcare Public Health

- A review has been circulated to DsPH to help them self-assess their current offer of public health advice to their integrated care boards. Meetings are being arranged with each team to discuss approaches and select case studies and areas to highlight within a final document to showcase the SW work taking place in this public health area.
