

# Multiple reinforcing approaches to change in a (people based) complex, adaptive system

- 1. convene and listen (Engage)
- 2. share real facts, and real stories (Educate)
- 3. demonstrate current action (Exemplify)
- 4. make action allowable, easy and desirable (Enable)
- 5. reframe: +ve aligning of benefits/values (Encourage)
- 6. make it normal (Expect)
- 7. make it unacceptable/shameful (Embarrass organisations)
- 8. make it compulsory / seal positive change (Enforce)
