1.	Test of Reinfection (Chlamydia)	Routine chlamydia test of Re-infection at 3-months.

2.	Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC)	<ul> <li>Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible;</li> <li>EHC core offer of EllaOne should be available, with Levonorgestrel supplied where clinically indicated;</li> <li>POP should be issued as a 6-month supply, along with a supply of condoms.</li> </ul>
3.	Contraception	<ul> <li>Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible;</li> <li>A core offer of POP should be made, issuing a 6-month supply.</li> </ul>
4.	Treatment of Chlamydia	<ul> <li>Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible;</li> <li>All possible STI treatment should be issued utilising postal dispensing;</li> <li>In line with national COVID-19 planning, age restrictions to treatment for those aged 16+ be suspended;</li> <li>Only those aged under 16 years; most vulnerable; or the highest risk, should be actively managed into specialist services.</li> </ul>
