	Elements of Service	Pandemic Plan

1.	Test of Reinfection (Chlamydia)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Routine chlamydia test of Re-infection at 3-months.

2.	Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible; EHC core offer of EllaOne should be available, with Levonorgestrel supplied where clinically indicated; POP should be issued as a 6-month supply, along with a supply of condoms.
3.	Contraception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible; A core offer of POP should be made, issuing a 6-month supply.
4.	Treatment of Chlamydia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Telemedicine and postal services should be utilised, wherever possible; All possible STI treatment should be issued utilising postal dispensing; In line with national COVID-19 planning, age restrictions to treatment for those aged 16+ be suspended; Only those aged under 16 years; most vulnerable; or the highest risk, should be actively managed into specialist services.
